7 DECEMBER - ARRIVAL AND WELCOMING NIGHT EVENT

8 DECEMBER

A PEDAGOGICAL APPROACH TO THE THEORY AND PRACTICE OF CIVIC AGENCY FROM THE LOCAL TO THE GLOBAL

MORNING SESSION - Sharing information about personal experiences and specific needs of own school/educational community and context. Peer-to-peer exchange on past experiences at the European level and personal expectations about the MultiScale EU training.

AFTERNOON SESSION - Lecture and debate: the "multiscale civic education" pedagogical framework. Learning objectives and planning, classroom practice, inter-personal cooperation with colleagues.

9 DECEMBER

DIDACTIC PRACTICE AND EXPERIMENTATIONS

MORNING SESSION - Authentic task experimentation. Problem-based collective reflection and deliberation on a topic chosen together, including experimentation of different voting methods and "DEMOCRATIC" prerequisites. This experimentation will provide participants with on-field experience of an original and transferable didactic methodology at the core of the MultiScale EU curriculum.

AFTERNOON SESSION - Cooperative workshop. Participants in couples will have to collaboratively imagine and prepare a draft learning unit drawing from the Multiscale EU didactic repository. The output should involve both their classes in parallel, including some kind of interaction and a shared deliverable.

10 DECEMBER

EUROPEAN TEACHERS AS EUROPEAN CITIZENS: PEDAGOGICAL AND POLITICAL CHALLENGES

MORNING SESSION - Lecture and debate: the "EU in question". Providing a better understanding of a key arena for our collective life today: contested issues, open contradictions and the power dynamics of the European construction.

AFTERNOON SESSION - Citizenship education at the European scale. Presentation of the Virtual Learning Environment on Europeans' Unity and parallel working groups, differentiated by disciplinary areas and school levels, on how to translate into consistent learning units and individual/class work planning the MultiScale EU approach.
